2009 COMPETITION RULES

1. Entry limited to paid-up members of the Agricultural Society.
2. For all grain crops, Registered or Certified Seed must be used, except a competitor may show seed which he had grown from 2008 registered seed and show proof of registration.
3. Must have an area of not less than FIVE acres.
4. Competitor must make an exhibit on Friday, September 18th, at Fair Grounds in his/her particular competition, Corn, Soya Beans, Oats, etc.
5. Total Points – Field Plus House.
