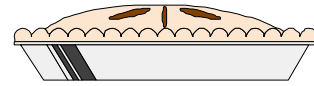

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES CAREFULLY.

** BAKING WILL NOT BE SOLD IN THE BUILDING

1. All exhibits in competition in this class must be as specified or are not eligible for competition. Also, in case of no competition: unless the exhibit is worthy, the prize will be withheld. **One article cannot be entered in more than ONE class unless chosen by the Judge to enter for sweepstakes.**
2. Judges are to start judging at **1:00 p.m. sharp.** Judges' decision is final.
3. Bread score: Flavor- 35%, Crust- 30%, Lightness-15 %, Crumb-10%, Appearance 10%. Total 100 Points.
Bread pan Maximum 9 x 5 x 3 Minimum 8 x 4 x 2 1/2
Recommended for uniformity by the O. A. A. S.
Where recipe is requested, it is for educational purposes only.
4. Bake Ambassador not eligible two consecutive years.
5. All cakes will be judged on cake as well as decorations unless specified by retaineer.
6. **We request all baking to be in clean plastic bags large enough for easy removal. No saran or similar wrapping please. Attach entry form to outside of bag if possible.**
7. Pies in 8 - 10 " foil plate. New foil plates need to be tempered by placing them in hot oven (450) for 10 to 15 minutes prior to use. This ensures bottom crust will bake.
8. Only desserts not requiring refrigeration are eligible for entering.
9. Muffin papers **must** be removed before entering, except cupcakes.
