O.A.A.S. QUILT COMPETITION

Each local Fair is entitled to send only the Grand Champion quilt (judged best of show in all classes) to the District Annual Meeting Competition. In cases where the winner has already had his/her quilt picked a winner at a previous Fair, the second prize quilt will be eligible. The winning quilt will go from the local Fair to the District 13 Annual Meeting in November 2009 where along with District winners will be judged again and the winner will go to the Ontario Agricultural Societies Convention in Toronto in February 2010. The entry judged BEST OF SHOW at the February Convention will be declared the ONTARIO ASSOCIATION OF AGRICULTURAL SOCIETIES' CHAMPIONSHIP QUILT. A \$500.00 GRAND PRIZE will be awarded and the Exhibitor will retain ownership of the quilt. A certificate and ribbon will also be awarded to the winner.

QUILTS MUST BE AT LEAST DOUBLE BED SIZE (72" X 90"). All quilts must be made and quilted solely by the exhibitor. In addition, prize money of \$25.00 for first place, \$15.00 for second place and \$10.00 for third place will be given to exhibitors of winning quilts at each District Competition. **A complete list of rules and regulations may be obtained from the Secretary.**

O.A.A.S *Machine* Championship Quilt Competition

Entries must be solely made and machine quilted (by individual and exhibited and judged at a local Ontario Association of Agricultural Society (OAAS) Fair to be eligible for this competition. Entry quilts must be a minimum of 72" x 90" (smaller quilts will not be eligible to proceed to the next levels of competition.) Judging will occur at local fairs and district levels. A Provincial Grand Champion Machine Quilt will be selected at the Annual Convention of OAAS. Upon making an entry into the Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies Machine Quilt Competition, the exhibitor agrees to participate in any promotional activities related to the competition. The winning OAAS Champion Machine Quilt will not be eligible to compete in any future District and/or Convention OAAS competition. The winner's name to be displayed at the Fair on sign provided by OAAS. The quilt must not quilted using a long arm machine and must be machine quilted by the exhibitor not a professional. **A complete list of rules and regulations may be obtained from the Secretary.**
