2. Poster size: Minimum of 8 1/2" x 11" (23 cm x 28 cm)  
Maximum of 12" x 18" (30.5 cm x 46 cm).
3. Each entry must be mounted on a black art card to give a 2" (5 cm) border.
4. On the back of the poster you must include the name of the student, the student's age, and phone number, and school.
5. The poster will be judged and displayed at the Plympton-Wyoming Fall Fair with the other Art exhibits.
6. **NO** entries will be accepted after **12 Noon** on **Friday, September 18th, 2009.**
