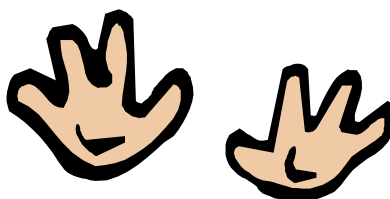

4) Flavour	-- 45 points

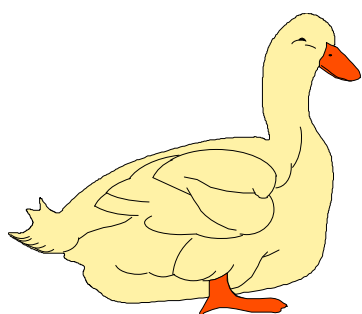
